



Safety Beach Sailing Club Child Safe Standards Statement

Victoria's new Child Safe Standards commenced on 1 July 2022 and need to be implemented by all clubs and organisations which deal with children.

Safety Beach Sailing Club (SBSC) will be introducing new policies and procedures to comply with these new standards. Further details to follow.

All children have a right to feel and be safe and the welfare of the children attending the club will always be a top priority with a zero-tolerance approach to abuse and harm.

Our club values diversity and we promote safety for all children of ethnically, culturally and linguistically diverse backgrounds and those with disability.

SBSC recognises that discrimination can harm children and we treat all children with dignity and respect.

All members, volunteers, contractors and third-party suppliers are responsible for promoting the safety, wellbeing and empowerment of children. We encourage all members to inform themselves about child safety, the new Victorian Child Safe Standards, club policies and procedures.

We all have a duty of care to our children and we encourage all members, including children, to report anything they feel is in breach of these new standards.

All reports will be treated with full confidentiality.
